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Sec. 2. Reversion to State. Resolved: That property conveyed by the State pursuant to this resolve must be accepted, maintained and used for the purposes of marine research by the Bigelow Laboratory for Ocean Sciences. The conveyance is subject to all limitations and conditions that apply to the State's present ownership. The property may not be reconveyed, leased or rented to another party. The Bigelow Laboratory for Ocean Sciences shall be responsible for all costs of operating and maintaining the property. If the Commissioner of Marine Resources, or the commissioner's successor, determines that the conditions of this resolve are not being met, title and ownership of the property must revert to the State.

Costs associated with the conveyance will be absorbed by the Department of Marine 8 Resources utilizing existing budgeted resources.' 10 STATEMENT OF FACT 12 14 This amendment replaces the resolve. The amendment requires that land transferred by the State to the Bigelow Laboratory for Ocean Sciences must be used for purposes relating to marine 16 research and specifies as a condition of the transfer that Bigelow Laboratory for Ocean Sciences must provide for public 18 access and joint development rights with the Department of Marine 20 Resources to a parcel of land it currently holds in Southport. If the Commissioner of Marine Resources determines that the parcel of land transferred by the State is not being used for 22 marine research, ownership of the property reverts to the State.
