	This amendment strikes a sentence in the bill granting broad

	chartered in Private and Special Law 1911, chapter 142 as the

	Farmington Village Corporation powers of eminent domain and
8	strictly limits those powers to the acquisition of property or
	property interests necessary to acquire an underground water
10	supply and to store and distribute that water.
12	The amendment does not affect provisions in the bill
•	pertaining to condemnation orders, notice to property owners,

1 determination of just compensation and the rights of appeal for 14 aggrieved persons.
