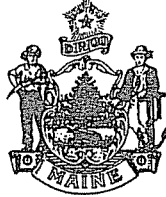

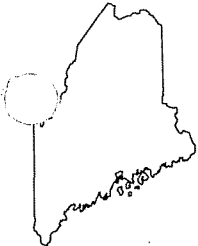

An Act Relating to Staff of the Maine State Retirement System.

(AFTER DEADLINE)



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

3 5 MRSA §17105, sub-§3, as amended by PL 1987, c. 402, Pt. A,
4 §§66 and 67, is further amended to read:

6 3. Staff. The personnel staff of the executive director:

8 A. ~~Shall-be~~ Are considered state employees and ~~shall-be~~ are
9 subject to all the provisions of state law regarding state
10 employees; ~~except that, notwithstanding any other statute,~~
11 the retirement system shall administer all personnel matters
12 relating to its employees. The executive director may
13 coordinate personnel activities with the Department of
14 Administration to provide for consistent application of the
15 Civil Service Law and rules when appropriate;

16 B. ~~Shall-be~~ Are employed under the ~~rules-established-by-the~~

18 C. ~~Shall-receive~~ Receive such compensation as is provided

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STATEMENT OF FACT

28 The purpose of this bill is to provide the Board of Trustees
29 of the Maine State Retirement System with more autonomy in
30 exercising its fiduciary responsibilities under the laws
31 governing the Maine State Retirement System in matters relating
32 to personnel employed by the system. However, this change will
33 not affect the benefits or the standing of the employees under
34 the civil service laws and rules or collective bargaining
contracts.
