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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill specifies that at least one member of the Animal Welfare Board represent a state licensed animal shelter, and at least one member represent an unlicensed humane society. The bill also establishes an advisory committee to aid the board in developing rules concerning the licensing of animal shelters, pet shops, boarding kennels and kennels.
