## STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This amendment requires animal control shelters to hold dogs at least 8 days before euthanasia unless a veterinarian 4 authorizes euthanasia for medical reasons. The amendment allows the shelter to assume ownership of a dog for the purposes of 6 adoption immediately upon determining that the dog is abandoned. 8 The amendment also requires animal control shelters to establish

and collect fees to offset the cost of keeping dogs beyond 6 days when the dog is reclaimed or adopted.
