SENATE AMENDMENT "D" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P.  
696, L.D. 1861, Bill, "An Act to Expand the Membership of the  
Animal Welfare Board"

Amend the amendment in section 40 in that part designated  
"\$4101." by striking out all of subsection 8.

Further amend the amendment in section 40 in that part  
designated "\$4101." by renumbering the subsections to read  
consecutively.


Further amend the amendment in section 40 by striking out  
all that part designated "\$4104."

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment represents the recommendation of the Joint  
Standing Committee on Judiciary upon review of the liability  
provisions of the new chapter on equine activities.

The amendment deletes the definition of "inherent risks of  
equine activities" being added in the new chapter on equine  
activities because the effect such a definition may have on the  
liability of participants, equine professionals and equine  
activity sponsors is unknown and may be unintended.

The amendment also deletes the apparently unnecessary  
posting requirement, which does not provide useful information  
and may be misleading to participants.
