SENATE AMENDMENT "E" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 696, L.D. 1861, Bill, "An Act to Expand the Membership of the Animal Welfare Board"

Amend the amendment in section 53 in subsection 2 in the 4th line (page 26, line 9 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "Act" the following: ', except that, notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 7, section 3903-A, the most recently appointed humane society representative may serve out the remainder of that person's term and the incumbent member who is a veterinarian may serve the remainder of that person's term'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies the transition provisions of the committee amendment by permitting the most recently appointed humane society representative and the incumbent veterinarian to serve out the remainder of their terms as members of the Animal Welfare Board.
