This amendment requires animal control shelters to hold dogs at least 11 days before euthanasia unless a veterinarian authorizes euthanasia for medical reasons. The amendment allow the shelter to assume ownership of a dog for the purposes of adoption immediately upon determining that the dog is abandoned. The amendment also requires animal control shelters to establish and collect fees to offset the cost of keeping dogs beyond 6 days when the dog is reclaimed or adopted.
