STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

Resolve, to Establish a Commission to Arrange for the Display of the Flags of Maine's Desert Storm Units in the Hall of Flags of the State House.

(AFTER DEADLINE)

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Sec. 1. Commission established. Resolved: That a commission is established to arrange for the display in the Hall of Flags in the State House of the flags of the Maine units that participated in the Persian Gulf War; and be it further

Sec. 2. Commission membership. Resolved: That the commission consists of the following 6 members: two members representing the Disabled American Veterans; 2 members representing the American Legion; and 2 members representing the Veterans of Foreign Wars to be nominated by their organizations and confirmed by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives; and be it further

Sec. 3. Duties. Resolved: That the commission shall develop a plan to make arrangements to have the flags of the Maine units that participated in the Persian Gulf War displayed in the Hall of Flags. The commission shall submit its plan to the Legislative Council for review and approval.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve creates a commission to arrange for the display in the Hall of Flags in the State House of the flags of the Maine units that participated in the Persian Gulf War.

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
