Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 4-A in the first paragraph in the 6th line (page 1, line 27 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "prescription," the following: 'at no cost,'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in the 2nd block paragraph in the 4th line from the end (page 2, line 2 in amendment) by striking out the following: "A person" and inserting in its place the following: 'Any person, corporation or other entity,'

Further amend the amendment in section 4 in that part designated "\$2600." in the first paragraph in the 5th line (page 2, line 44 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "prescription," the following: 'at no cost,'

Further amend the amendment in section 4 in the 2nd paragraph from the end in the 4th line from the end (page 3, line 15 in amendment) by striking out the following: "A person" and inserting in its place the following: 'Any person, corporation or other entity,'

Further amend the amendment in section 5 in that part designated "\$3300." in the first paragraph in the 5th line (page 3, line 35 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "prescription," the following: 'at no cost,'

Further amend the amendment in section 5 in the 2nd paragraph from the end in the 4th line from the end (page 4, line
