' 26 Further amend the bill at the end before the statement of 28 fact by inserting the following: 'FISCAL NOTE 30 The total cost of this bond issue is estimated to be 32 \$46,990,625 with principal payments of \$27,500,000 and interest 34 payments of approximately \$19,490,625. The debt service obligation to the Highway Fund would be a total amount of 36 \$42,718,750 (\$25,000,000 in principal payments and approximately \$17,718,750 in interest payments). The debt service obligation 38 to the General Fund would be a total amount of \$4,271,875 (\$2,500,000 in principal payments and approximately \$1,771,875 in 40 interest payments). 42 estimated cost of sending this question out referendum will vary according to the total number of referenda. 44 The estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum 46 costs an additional \$6,500.'
