An Act to Amend and Extend the Fuel Assistance Reserve Fund.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §3518-B, as enacted by PL 1989, c. 884, §1, is amended to read:

§3518-B. Energy Assistance Reserve Fund

- The division shall use 1. Energy Assistance Reserve Fund. funds appropriated pursuant to this section to establish and capitalize the Fuel Energy Assistance Reserve Fund. The division 10 shall keep the Fuel-Assistance-Reserve-Fund fund separate from all other funds managed by the division and use the fund only, 12 without exception, under the conditions set forth in this 14 section. The Division of Community Services division shall use the Fuel--Assistance--Reserve--Fund fund to ensure that fuel assistance benefits under the home energy assistance program and 16 the energy crisis intervention program for the State's eligible elderly and low-income residents are available prior to the 18 beginning of the heating season. The fund may not be used for 20 the weatherization assistance program and the central heating improvement program.
- Timely distribution of benefits. The--Division--of 24 Community-Services For at least the months of October, November and December, the division shall make available to local program operators and municipal administrators of the fuel assistance 26 program, no later than Oeteber-1st-of-each-year the first of each 28 of those months, funds sufficient to cover anticipated fuel assistance payments under the home energy assistance program and 30 the energy crisis intervention program and program administrative costs for at-least-the each of those months ef-October, - November 32 and-December respectively.
 - 3. Conditional use of the fund. The division's use of the fund is subject to the following conditions and limitations.
 - A. If the director reasonably anticipates that federal fuel assistance block grant funds are not available for distribution to the local program operators and municipal administrators by October 1st of each year, the division shall withdraw and distribute sufficient money from the fund as is necessary for the purposes set forth in this section. The division may withdraw funds prior to October 1st, provided that those funds are used only for costs incurred on or after October 1st.

Money may not be withdrawn from the fund if sufficient block grant funds are available to pay reasonably anticipated fuel assistance program and administrative costs as set forth in this section for the months of October, November and December.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

12 This bill extends the Fuel Assistance Reserve Fund, established in 1990, for one year and renames it the Energy Assistance Reserve Fund to more appropriately describe the uses 14 of the fund. This bill allows the fund to be used for the energy 16 crisis intervention program, which assists families in emergency situations, as well as for the payment of regular fuel assistance 18 benefits.

20 This bill requires the Division of Community Services to distribute, no later than the first of each month, sufficient 22 funds to local program operators and municipal administrators of the fuel assistance program to cover anticipated program and administrative costs for at least the months of October, November 24 and December. The bill allocates \$8,000,000 to the Division of 26 Community Services for recapitalizing the Energy Assistance Reserve Fund. The fund may be used as start-up funding for the fuel assistance program only if federal block grant funding is not received by October 1st. If the fund is used, the division is required to recapitalize the fund by June 30, 1992.
