COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 705, L.D. 1876, Bill, "An Act to Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of \$5,000,000 for Major Improvements and Renovations at State Park Facilities and the Restoration and Preservation of Historic Buildings"

Amend the bill in section 1 in the 6th line from the end (page 1, line 21 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "public" the following: ', including the State House, which is not subject to the matching requirement.'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in the 4th line from the end (page 1, line 23 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "10" and inserting in its place the following: '5'

Further amend the bill in section 6 in the 11th line (page 2, line 21 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Recreation" and inserting in its place the following: 'Recreation.'

Further amend the bill in section 6 in the 2nd line from the end (page 2, line 27 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "buildings" the following: ', including the State House.'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

The total cost of this bond issue is estimated to be \$5,840,000 with principal payments of \$5,000,000 and interest payments of approximately \$840,000.
