SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1304, L.D. 1886, Bill, "An Act to Repeal the Laws Allowing the State to Participate in Lotto*America"

Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the title and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 8 MRSa §372, sub-§2, ¶I, as amended by PL 1989, c. 879, §§1 and 4, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

I. Carry on a continuous study and investigation of the lotteries throughout the State and the operation and administration of similar laws that may be in effect in other states or countries.

Sec. 2. Effective date. Section 1 of this Act takes effect on July 1, 1993.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment repeals that section of the statutes allowing the state to participate in Lotto*America effective July 1, 1993. The exact impact on future General Fund revenues can not be determined at this time.' '
