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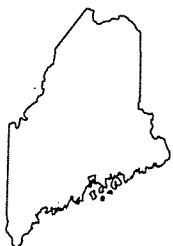

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**An Act to Repeal the Laws Allowing the State to Participate in  
Lotto\*America.**

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(AFTER DEADLINE)



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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§ MRSA §372, sub-§2, ¶I, as amended by PL 1989, c. 879, §§1 and 4, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

I. Carry on a continuous study and investigation of the lotteries throughout the State and the operation and administration of similar laws that may be in effect in other states or countries.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill removes the State Lottery director's authority to enter into agreements with the Multi-State Lottery Association, known as Lotto\*America.
