COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1309, L.D. 1891, Bill, "An Act Concerning Railroad Personnel"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 4. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Provides funds to refund all fees paid by individuals to the Board of Licensure of Railroad Personnel.

FISCAL NOTE

APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS

General Fund \$34,600

This bill eliminates the Board of Licensure of Railroad Personnel, which by court ruling has been deemed

2 unconstitutional. The bill requires the Department of
Professional and Financial Regulation to refund all fees from
4 licensing and examination paid by individuals under the Maine
Revised Statutes, Title 32, chapter 60. Since the board does not
6 have sufficient resources to return these fees, a General Fund
appropriation to the Department of Professional and Financial
Regulation of \$34,600 in fiscal year 1991-92 is required.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendments adds an appropriation and fiscal note to the
bill.
