unconstitutional. The bill requires the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation to refund all fees from licensing and examination paid by individuals under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 32, chapter 60. Since the board does not have sufficient resources to return these fees, a General Fund appropriation to the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation of \$34,600 in fiscal year 1991-92 is required.'
