## STATEMENT OF FACT

6           Following ratification of a bond issue that allowed for  
8 improvements in public safety facilities the Legislature  
10 allocated the proceeds from the sale of the bonds to certain  
12 public safety projects. Some projects have been completed and  
14 others have been started or are in the planning stage. The  
16 allocated balances for the projects need to be adjusted to allow  
for completion. In addition, further study has shown that the  
barracks at Thomaston should be replaced rather than repaired.  
This resolve adjusts the balances between projects and amends the  
language regarding the Thomaston site to allow for new  
construction rather than building repair.
