An Act to Amend the Classification of the St. George River.

(AFTER DEADLINE)



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Dam rebuilding and maintenance authorized. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 38, section 465, subsection 1; section 467, subsection 14, paragraph A, subparagraph (1); and section 480-C, Ivan Davis is authorized to rebuild and maintain the dam on the St. George River in Liberty that is the first dam below the outlet of Lake St. George and is adjacent to land owned by Ivan Davis.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill authorizes the rebuilding and maintenance of a dam on the St. George River in Liberty that might have been authorized by the Department of Environmental Protection but for the reclassification of the river segment from Class C to Class AA effective July 14, 1990. The bill does not authorize the use of the dam as a hydropower project as it does not create an exception to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 38, section 633.
