HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1314, L.D. 1900, Bill, "An Act to Create the Plymouth Water District"

Amend the amendment in the 2nd paragraph after the title in the 3rd line (page 1, line 21 in amendment) by striking out the following: "568" and inserting in its place the following: '1364, subsection 5'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment corrects a reference to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 38. The committee amendment referred to Title 38, section 568, which is the provision that allows the Commissioner of Environmental Protection to install a new water system in an area contaminated by the discharge of oil. This amendment changes the reference to Title 38, section 1364, which allows the commissioner to take the same actions in regard to a water system contaminated by uncontrolled hazardous substances. The Plymouth Water District will be receiving funds under this latter provision and not under the former.
