COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1314, L.D. 1900, Bill, "An Act to Create the Plymouth Water District"

Amend the bill in section 13 by inserting at the end the following:

'The management and allocation by the Plymouth Water District of a contribution of funds by the State under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 38, section 568, and the income from those funds, are not subject to investigation or review by the Public Utilities Commission under Title 35-A, section 310, 1302 or 1303, except upon request by the Department of Environmental Protection.'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill establishes the Plymouth Water District. The Public Utilities Commission will absorb the costs associated with rate review within existing budgeted resources.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment exempts from review by the Public Utilities Commission under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 35-A, section 310, 1302 or 1303 any funds allocated by the Department of Environmental Protection to the Plymouth Water District under Title 38, section 568, unless a review is requested by the

2 Department of Environmental Protection. As a result, the
allocation and management by the district of funds that the
4 district receives from the Department of Environmental Protection
for the installation of a new public water supply because of
6 contamination of existing water supplies from discharges of oil
will not be reviewed by the Public Utilities Commission. This
amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
