COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1315, L.D. 1901, Bill, "An Act to Create the Morrill Village Water District"

Amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency preamble and inserting in its place the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the Morrill Village Water District must take action as soon as possible to purchase the Morrill Water Company and become operational; and

Whereas, the timely appointment of the trustees is essential to the administration of the Morrill Village Water District; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, '

Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

This bill creates the Morrill Village Water District. The Public Utilities Commission will absorb the costs associated with rate review within existing budgeted resources.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment changes the emergency preamble of the bill.

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This amendment also adds a fiscal note.
