COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1319, L.D. 1909, Bill, "An Act to Regulate Certain Warranty Practices for Repairs to Watercraft"

Amend the bill in that part designated "§1197." in subsection 1 in paragraph A in the first line (page 2, line 12 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Adequately and fairly compensate the franchisee" and inserting in its place the following: 'Reimburse the franchisee at the retail rate customarily charged'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The bill requires that a franchised watercraft dealer be adequately and fairly reimbursed by the manufacturer for parts used in satisfying a warranty. This amendment requires that the franchisee be reimbursed at the retail rate. This matches a change made last year to a similar law for automobile warranties.
