COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1321, L.D. 1912, Bill, "An Act to Promote Long-term Economic Development"

Amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "Maine Science and Technology Commission - Centers for Innovation" in the first TOTAL column under 1991-92 (page 2, line 24 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$917,200" and inserting in its place the following: '\$915,200'

Further amend the bill in section 2 by striking out the last line (page 3, line 45 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'TOTAL \$1,661,515 \$3,095,791'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

1991-92 1992-93

APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS

General Fund \$1,661,515 \$3,095,791

This bill provides General Fund appropriations for the Maine Science and Technology Commission of \$1,661,515 in fiscal year 1991-92 and \$3,095,791 in fiscal year 1992-93 for economic development activities. The bill also requires the commission to evaluate mechanisms to integrate research and development into the State's economic development strategy and to report its findings to the Governor and the Legislature. The costs associated with the study and report will be covered within the amounts appropriated by the bill.'
