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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1326, L.D. 1918

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment raises the sales tax rate to 8%, an increase of 1% above the level included in other legislation. It would raise and appropriate \$15,900,000 in General Fund revenue.
