HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1333, L.D. 1924, Bill, "An Act Concerning the Low-income Home Energy Assistance Program"

Amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency preamble and all of the emergency clause.

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill requires that 15% of the funds received by the Division of Community Services under the Low-income Home Energy Assistance Program be transferred to the Maine State Housing Authority for use in energy conservation programs.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment strikes the emergency preamble and emergency clause from the bill. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill that was inadvertently removed by Senate Amendment "B" to Committee Amendment "A," S.P. 362.
