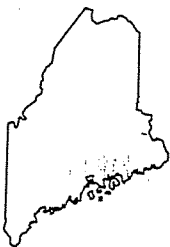

An Act to Amend the Berwick Sewer District Charter.

(AFTER DEADLINE)



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. P&SL 1963, c. 154, §24 is enacted to read:

6       **Sec. 24. Dissolution.** The district may be dissolved by  
affirmative vote of a majority of the legal voters voting at a  
8       municipal election on the question: "Shall the Berwick Sewer  
District, created as a quasi-municipal corporation by Private and  
10       Special Act, be dissolved?" Prior to dissolution, the district  
shall adequately provide for the transfer of the district's  
12       assets, liabilities and responsibilities.

14       **Sec. 2. Town of Berwick; duties upon dissolution.** Upon  
dissolution of the Berwick Sewer District, as created by Private  
16       and Special Law 1963, chapter 154, the Town of Berwick shall  
assume the assets, liabilities and responsibilities of the  
18       district.

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This bill allows the Berwick Sewer District to be dissolved  
24       by a majority of the voters voting at a municipal election and  
provides that upon that dissolution, the Town of Berwick will  
26       assume the district's assets, liabilities and responsibilities.
