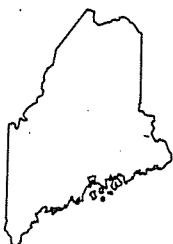

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

P&SL 1957, c. 9 is amended to read:

16 This bill changes the minimum quorum requirement for action
at special town meetings in the Town of Vassalboro to 125 voters
rather than 10% of the total number of votes cast for Governor in
