IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Amend the Quorum Requirements for Special Town Meetings in Vassalboro.

(AFTER DEADLINE)

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

P&SL 1957, c. 9 is amended to read:

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Special town meetings. No action of a special town meeting of the town of Vassalboro, Kennebec County, shall-be is valid unless the number of 125 registered voters are present at such the special town meeting shall-equal at least 10% of the total number of votes cast for Governor in said town of Vassalboro at the next preceding gubernatorial election.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill changes the minimum quorum requirement for action at special town meetings in the Town of Vassalboro to 125 voters rather than 10% of the total number of votes cast for Governor in the last election.
