SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1343, L.D. 1934, Bill, "An Act to Appropriate Funds from the General Fund for Search and Rescue Activities"

Amend the bill by striking out all of the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Eliminate the Requirement of Reimbursement for Search and Rescue Activities'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'12 MRSA §7035, sub-§4, ¶B, as amended by PL 1983, c. 819, Pt. A, §19, is repealed.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to eliminate the requirement that the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife be reimbursed by the General Fund for search and rescue operations.
