Resolve, for Laying of the County Taxes and Authorizing Expenditures of York County for the Year 1991.

(EMERGENCY)

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Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after 2 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 4 Whereas, York County has certain expenses and liabilities that must be met as they become due; and 6 8 Whereas, it is necessary that the taxes for the year 1991 mentioned be immediately assessed in order to provide the 10 required revenue for the county; and 12 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately 14 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it 16 Sec. 1. York County; taxes apportioned. Resolved: 18 That the following sum is granted as a tax on York County to be 20 apportioned, assessed, collected and applied to the purposes of paying debts and necessary expenses of the county as authorized in this resolve, and for other purposes of law, for the calendar 22 year 1991: 24 1991 TAX 26 \$3,737,898 28 ; and be it further 30 Sec. 2. General Fund expenditures authorized.
