Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Provides funds to purchase civil rights liability coverage from the Department of Administration, Risk Management Division and to pay the deductible amount on an existing claim for payment of attorney's fees in Auburn Police Union v. Tierney.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides funds to the Department of the Attorney General to purchase civil rights liability coverage and to pay the deductible on an existing claim for payment of attorney's fees in Auburn Police Union v. Tierney. Payment of the premium and the deductible will enable the Risk Management Division to cover the payment of court-awarded attorney's fees in that case.
