COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 1354, L.D. 1946, Bill, "An Act to Allow the Risk Management Division to Provide Insurance 14 Services for Elementary and Secondary Schools in the State"

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Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1.

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 and 20 inserting in its place the following:

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'Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §1728-A, sub-§§1-A and 1-B are enacted to read:

24 Additional duties. The director shall provide <u>1-A.</u> insurance advice and services for all lines of property and 26 casualty insurance for school administrative units and for private schools approved for tuition purposes more than 60% of 28 whose students are publicly funded. All liabilities over \$300,000 per occurrence must be reinsured by the director, with 30 the insured entity paying the cost of that reinsurance. In performing the functions authorized by this subsection the 32 director is not subject to the provisions of Title 24-A.

34 1-B. Rulemaking. The commissioner, with the advice of the director, shall adopt rules to ensure that the fund is adequately 36 funded and that the assets of the fund are protected.'

38 Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read consecutively. 40

Further amend the bill at the end before the statement of 42 fact by inserting the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

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This bill authorizes the Department of Administration, Risk Management Division, to provide insurance advice and services to school administrative units. Schools that choose to self-insure 48

through the Risk Management Division could realize savings in insurance expenditures, which could reduce future expenses to the 2 Department of Education, General Purpose Aid to Local Schools 4 account.

The bill further requires the Risk Management Division to 6 contract for annual actuarial services and to adopt rules to ensure that the insurance fund is adequately funded and the 8 assets of the fund are protected, the cost of which can be absorbed within existing resources.' 10

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment deletes the requirement that a separate fund be set up within the Risk Management Division for the family 16 foster homes, respite care providers, Casco Bay Island Transit District and schools. It also provides rule-making authority to 18 ensure that the fund is adequately funded and that the assets of the fund are protected. 20
