	whose students are publicly funded. All liabilities over \$300,000 per occurrence must be reinsured by the director, with
	the insured entity paying the cost of that reinsurance. In performing the functions authorized by this subsection the
	director is not subject to the provisions of Title 24-A.
	1-B. Rulemaking. The commissioner, with the advice of the
	director, shall adopt rules to ensure that the fund is adequately funded and that the assets of the fund are protected.'
	Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read

	Further amend the bill at the end before the statement of fact by inserting the following:
	FISCAL NOTE
	This bill authorizes the Department of Administration, Risk
	Management Division, to provide insurance advice and services to

through the Risk Management Division could realize savings in insurance expenditures, which could reduce future expenses to the Department of Education, General Purpose Aid to Local Schools account.

The bill further requires the Risk Management Division to contract for annual actuarial services and to adopt rules to ensure that the insurance fund is adequately funded and the assets of the fund are protected, the cost of which can be absorbed within existing resources.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment deletes the requirement that a separate fund be set up within the Risk Management Division for the family foster homes, respite care providers, Casco Bay Island Transit District and schools. It also provides rule-making authority to ensure that the fund is adequately funded and that the assets of the fund are protected.
