Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the 2 Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 4 Whereas, Somerset County has certain expenses andliabilities that must be met as they become due; and 6 8 Whereas, it is necessary that the taxes for the year 1991 mentioned be immediately assessed in order to provide the 10 required revenue for the county; and 12 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 14 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it 16 Sec. 1. Somerset County; taxes apportioned. Resolved: 18 That the following sum is granted as a tax on Somerset County to be apportioned, assessed, collected and applied to the purposes of 20 paying debts and necessary expenses of the county as authorized in this resolve, and for other purposes of law, for the calendar 22 year 1991: 24 1991 TAX 26 \$2,014,816 28 ; and be it further 30 Sec. 2. General Fund expenditures authorized.
