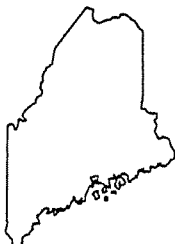

Resolve, Authorizing the Commissioner of Corrections to Enter into an Agreement with the Town of Thomaston for the Maine State Prison's Share of Upgrading the Town of Thomaston Sewer System.

(AFTER DEADLINE)

(EMERGENCY)



Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the
Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after
adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, there is an immediate need to begin work in order
to have the Town of Thomaston sewer system upgraded; and

Whereas, an agreement between the State, through the
Department of Corrections, and the Town of Thomaston is necessary
before work may begin; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety; now, therefore, be it

Resolved: That the Commissioner of Corrections is
authorized to enter into an agreement with the Town of Thomaston
specifying the Maine State Prison's share of the cost of
upgrading the Town of Thomaston sewer system and payment of user
fees by the Maine State Prison.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this resolve takes effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve authorizes the Commissioner of Corrections to
enter into an agreement with the Town of Thomaston specifying the
Maine State Prison's share of the cost of upgrading the sewer
system of the town and payment of user fees.
