HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 765, L.D. 1956, Bill, "An Act to Allow Nonprofit Organizations to Use Proceeds from Beano or Bingo for Limited Purposes"

Amend the bill in that part designated "§326." in subsection 1 in the 4th line (page 1, line 33 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "its employees." and inserting the following: 'any person directly and essentially involved in operating the beano, bingo or lucky seven game.'

Further amend the bill in that part designated "§326." in subsection 2 in the 6th line (page 1, line 45 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "games." the following: 'Payments under this section may not exceed 20% of the revenue generated by the games.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment limits the persons who may be compensated from the revenue generated by beano, bingo or lucky seven games to those persons who are directly and essentially involved in the operation of the games. This amendment limits the amount of compensation available to 20% of the revenue generated by the games.
