SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 765, L.D. 1956, Bill, "An Act to Allow Nonprofit Organizations to Use Proceeds from Beano or Bingo for Limited Purposes"

Amend the bill by adding at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

Costs associated with adopting rules and monitoring the payment of proceeds for employee wages by organizations licensed to operate beano, bingo or lucky seven games will be absorbed by the Department of Public Safety utilizing existing budgeted resources.'
