HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 1372, L.D. 1957, Bill, "An Act to Improve the Maine Workers' Compensation System"

Amend the bill in section 26 in paragraph A by striking out all of the last sentence (page 13, lines 43 to 47 in L.D.)

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 37.

Further amend the bill after section 104 by inserting the following:

'Sec. 105. Rate freeze; retroactivity. The workers' compensation insurance rates in effect on June 26, 1991, remain in effect until January 1, 1992. This section is retroactive to July 1, 1991.'

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment deletes the requirement that the Superintendent of Insurance adopt rules establishing an equipment allowance for loggers, deletes the requirement of posting a notice of workers' compensation coverage at each worksite and imposes a freeze on workers' compensation insurance rates retroactively to July 1, 1991.
