An Act to Fund a Collective Bargaining Agreement.

(EMERGENCY)

	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not			
2	become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and			
4	Whereas, certain obligations and expenses incident to the			
6	operation of a state collective bargaining agreement will become due and payable July 1, 1991; and

10	Whereas, it is the responsibility of the Legislature to act upon those portions of a collective bargaining agreement negotiated by the executive branch that require legislative

14	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of			
16	Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
