HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 774, L.D. 1968, Bill, "An Act to Authorize Payment of Payroll Obligations to Certain State Employees for Work Already Performed for which Payment was Scheduled on July 1, 1991"

Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting clause (page 1, line 18 in L.D.) the following:

'PART A'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the emergency clause the following:

'PART B'

Sec. B-1. Appropriations and allocations. In order to provide for necessary expenditures of State Government and other purposes for the period of 12:01 a.m. on July 1, 1991 until 11:59 p.m. on July 8, 1991, the following sums are appropriated or allocated out of any money not otherwise appropriated or allocated.

Other Funds Allocations	\$3,600,000

Sec. B-2. Expenditures. Expenditures under this Act must be made to provide necessary and essential services for the

2 people of this State, including services that generate revenue in  
excess of expenditures.

4 Sec. B-3. Lapsing of funds. Any funds appropriated or  
allocated but not expended during the period of July 1, 1991 to  
6 July 8, 1991 lapse to their respective funds.

8 Sec. B-4. Initiation or resumption of certain activities.  
Appropriations or allocations made available pursuant to this Act  
10 may not be used to initiate or resume any project or activity for  
which appropriations, allocations or other authorities were not  
12 available during fiscal year 1990-91.

14 Sec. B-5. Availability of appropriations and allocations.  
Appropriations and allocations made available and authority  
16 granted pursuant to this Act are available until enactment into  
law of a subsequent appropriation or allocation for any project  
18 or activity provided for in this Act, enactment into law of an  
applicable appropriations act without any provision for such  
20 project or activity or July 8, 1991, whichever first occurs.

22 Sec. B-6. Coverage of obligations or expenditures. Appropriations  
made and authority granted pursuant to this Act covers all  
24 obligations or expenditures incurred for any program, project or  
activity during the period for which funds or authority for such  
26 project or activity are available under this Act.

28 Sec. B-7. Authorization. Actions taken or expenditures made  
pursuant to this Act are authorized by law and are deemed to  
30 satisfy the provisions of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5,  
section 1543, first paragraph.

32 Sec. B-8. Transfers. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised  
34 Statutes, Title 5, section 1585, the State Budget Officer may  
transfer funds from the appropriations and allocations authorized  
36 in section 1 of this Act to the various departments and agencies  
of State Government to meet the purposes of this Act.'

38 Further amend the bill by relettering the Parts and  
40 renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

42 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the  
statement of fact the following:
