Resolve, to Ensure Operation of the Veterans' Memorial Cemetery.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the 2 Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, due to the closedown of Maine State Government, the б. cemetery superintendent of the Veterans' Memorial Cemetery has stopped accepting bodies for burial; and

Whereas, this situation places veterans and their families in an unconscionable position during periods of tremendous loss 10 and grief; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts 14 create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately 16 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

Sec. 1. Resolved: That the cemetery superintendent shall 20 resume and continue operations of the Veterans' Memorial Cemetery immediately upon the effective date of this resolve; and be it 22 further

Sec. 2. Appropriation. Resolved: That the following funds are 24 appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of 26 this resolve.
