HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1380, L.D. 1970, Bill, "An Act Making Unified Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Period of July 1, 1991 until July 8, 1991"

Amend the bill in section 1 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 25 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "July 1, 1991 until July 8, 1991" and inserting in its place the following: 'July 5, 1991 to July 10, 1991'

Further amend the bill in section 1 by striking out the last 4 lines (page 1, lines 31 to 37 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the following:

'General Fund Appropriation	\$77,000,000
Highway Fund Allocation	\$32,000,000
Federal Expenditure Fund Allocation	\$15,100,000
Other Funds Allocations	\$3,400,000'

Further amend the bill in section 3 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 45 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "July 1, 1991 to July 8, 1991" and inserting in its place the following: 'July 5, 1991 to July 10, 1991'

Further amend the bill in section 5 in the last line (page 2, line 10 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "July 8, 1991," and inserting in its place the following: 'July 10, 1991,'

2 Further amend the bill by striking out all of the fiscal
note and inserting in its place the following:
