An Act Making Unified Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Period of July 1, 1991 until July 8, 1991.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted 2 as emergencies; and Whereas, the 90-day period will terminate after expenditures authorized by this Act are necessary; and Whereas, certain obligations and expenses incident to the operation of state departments and institutions will become due 10 and payable immediately; and 12 Whereas, the Legislature has not enacted a biennial budget 14 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, 20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 22 Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations. In order to provide for necessary expenditures of State Government and other purposes for 24 the period of July 1, 1991 until July 8, 1991, the following sums are appropriated or allocated out of any money not otherwise 26 appropriated or allocated. 28 1991-92 30 \$74,500,000 General Fund Appropriation 32 Highway Fund Allocation \$33,900,000 34 Federal Expenditure Fund Allocation \$11,700,000 36 Other Funds Allocations \$3,600,000 38 Sec. 2. Expenditures. Expenditures under this Act must be made to provide necessary and essential services for the people 40 of this State, including services that generate revenue in excess 42 of expenditures. Sec. 3. Lapsing of funds. Any funds appropriated or allocated 44 but not expended during the period of July 1, 1991 to July 8, 46 1991 lapse to their respective funds. Initiation or resumption 48 of certain Appropriations or allocations made available pursuant to this Act may not be used to initiate or resume any project or activity for 50

which appropriations, allocations or other authorities were not available during fiscal year 1990-91.

- Sec. 5. Availability of appropriations and allocations. Appropriations and allocations made available and authority granted pursuant to this Act are available until enactment into law of a subsequent appropriation or allocation for any project or activity provided for in this Act, enactment into law of an applicable appropriations act without any provision for such project or activity or July 8, 1991, whichever first occurs.
- Sec. 6. Coverage of obligations or expenditures. Appropriations made and authority granted pursuant to this Act covers all obligations or expenditures incurred for any program, project or activity during the period for which funds or authority for such project or activity are available under this Act.
- Sec. 7. Authorization. Actions taken or expenditures made pursuant to this Act are authorized by law and are deemed to satisfy the provisions of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1543, first paragraph.
- Sec. 8. Transfers. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1585, the State Budget Officer may transfer funds from the appropriations and allocations authorized in section 1 of this Act to the various departments and agencies of State Government to meet the purposes of this Act.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.
