SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to S.P. 779, L.D. 1975, Bill, "An Act to Allow Agencies to Amend Legislative Agendas to Accommodate Unforseen Events"


Amend the bill in that part designated "~~§~~8064." by striking out all of the first paragraph (page 1, lines 28 to 34 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Except for emergency rules, as provided in section 8060, subsection 6, an agency may not adopt any rule unless the agency has complied with the provisions in sections 8053-A and 8060, which ~~includes~~ include legislative review of the rule. This provision does not apply to rules adopted pursuant to any federal law or regulation, or rules adopted pursuant to the Title 12, section 685-A.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment excludes federal laws and regulations and rules adopted pursuant to Maine Land Use Regulation Commission from the provisions of the bill.
