SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1389, L.D. 1977, Bill, "An Act to Make Unified Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government, Highway Fund, and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993"

Amend the bill in Part E in the first line (page 37, line 18 in L.D.) by inserting before the following: "Retroactivity." the following: 'Sec. E-1.'


Further amend the bill in Part E by inserting at the end the following:

'Sec. E-2. Repeal. This Act is repealed July 14, 1991.'
