30	use taxes. To compensate for the loss of budgeted revenue, this amendment eliminates an appropriation to the higher education
32	institutions established in another Part of this amendment as a
	repayment of a June 1991 deferral. In its place, this amendment
34	clarifies that the July 1991 payment is for the June 1991 deferral. The amendment provides that, beginning with the July
36	1991 payment, 1/12 of the annual General Fund appropriations to
