HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to SENATE AMENDMENT "D" to H.P. 1393, L.D. 1979, Bill, "An Act Providing Unified Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government, General Fund and Other Funds, and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1991, June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993"

Amend the amendment in section III-1 in that part designated "§7-B." in the first paragraph in the 5th line (page 1, line 31 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Bureau of Capitol Security;"

Further amend the amendment in section III-1 in that part designated "§7-B." in the first paragraph in the 7th line (page 1, line 33 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Bureau of Highway Safety;"

Further amend the amendment in section III-1 in that part designated "§7-B." in the first paragraph in the 8th to 10th lines (page 1, lines 34 to 36 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Division of Probation and Parole and other correctional officers in the Department of Corrections;"

Further amend the amendment in section III-1 in that part designated "§7-B." in the first paragraph in the 10th line (page 1, line 36 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "Fire Control;" the following: 'Bureau of Warden Service'
