SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1397,
L.D. 1981, Bill, "An Act to Make Changes in the Workers'
Compensation System"

Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the
title and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place
the following:

'Amend the bill in Part D in section D-20 in that part
designated "~~§92-A.~~" in subsection 2 in the last line (page 50,
line 6 in L.D.) by inserting at the end the following new
sentence to read:

'No health care provider who receives more than 50% of the
provider's income from a single employer, other than a health
care facility, is eligible to serve as an independent medical
examiner.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment prohibits any health care provider who
receives more than 50% of the provider's income from a single
employer from serving as an independent medical examiner.
