HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1397, L.D. 1981, Bill, "An Act to Make Changes in the Workers' Compensation System"

Amend the bill in Part D in section D-20 in that part designated "§92-A." in subsection 2 in the last line (page 30, line 6 in L.D.) by inserting at the end the following: 'A physician who has examined an employee at the request of an insurance company or employer in accordance with section 65 during the previous 52 weeks is not eligible to serve as an independent medical examiner.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment specifies that a physician who has examined an employee at the request of an insurance company or employer during the previous 52 weeks is not eligible to serve as an independent medical examiner.
